## **Board Regulation Community Building Grants Program**

Adopted (Board): February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2012 Amended (Board): May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2012

## 1. Operations

- a. Funds allocated in the DAGS budget under the line 'Community Building Grants Programs' shall be governed by this regulation.
- b. Grants valued up to \$500 will be distributed evenly over all three academic terms during the fiscal year.
- c. Events held in cooperation with any non-DAGS societies may be funded with Community Building Grants equalling contributions by non-DAGS societies, up to a maximum of \$500.
- d. Unused Community Building Grants may be allocated during the next term in the same fiscal year.
- e. An application form will be prepared and made available by the Board.
- f. Applications will be received by the Office Manager, and reviewed, assigned a monetary value, and approved by the Student Life Committee at a monthly meeting, by eligibility criteria outlined in this regulation.
- g. Regular reports on the health of the program will be prepared and presented to the Board.

## 2. Eligibility

- a. Community Building Grants may only be awarded to DAGS Member Societies paying DAGS fees. Grants may, however, be applied to events held in cooperation with non-DAGS societies.
- b. At least two DAGS Member Societies must co-apply for any given Community Building Grant.
- c. The applicants must be holding a social event for more than one society.
- d. Applications will not be accepted retroactively.
- e. No DAGS Member Society may receive more than one Community Building Grant in any academic term. Preference will be given to Member Societies that have not already received a Community Building Grant in the same fiscal year.
