## **Board Regulation**

## **Special Funding Grants Program**

Adopted (Board): February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2012 Amended (Board): April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2012

- 1. Operations
  - a. Funds allocated in the DAGS budget under the line 'Special Funding Grants Programs' shall be governed by this regulation.
  - b. Grants valued up to \$1000 will be distributed evenly over all three academic terms during the fiscal year.
  - c. An application form will be prepared and made available by the Board.
  - d. Applications will be presented to the Board, and reviewed and approved by the Board, by eligibility criteria outlined in this regulation.
  - e. Regular reports on the health of the program will be prepared and presented to the Board.
- 2. Eligibility
  - a. Special Funding Grants may only be awarded to DAGS Member Societies paying DAGS fees.
  - b. The applicant must be organizing a large-scale academic or professional development event.
  - c. Applications will not be accepted retroactively.
  - d. No DAGS Member Society may receive more than one Special Funding Grant in any fiscal year.
